on Sunday, June 30th and July 28th.

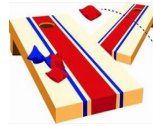

during the most important time in their lives!! Will that be you?*

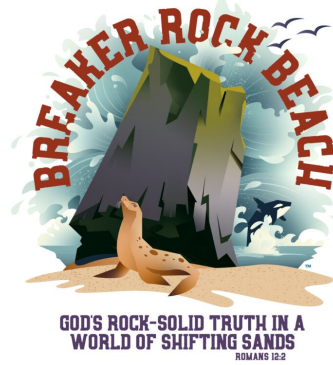
