I saw something on PBS recently that really bothered me. There is a show that Ciara really liked called: "Pinkalicious." It was a cute little show about a girl who loves the color pink and likes to pretend a lot. PBS has been free from the LGBTQ+ radical agenda up to recently, but no more unfortunately. Thankfully, Kimberly overheard what was being discussed and let me know after turning it off for the last time. This show portrayed a neighborhood kid as being from a family with two dads. It wasn't necessary at all; they were intentionally seeking to corrupt young minds into accepting perversion as normal. This is very dangerous stuff! Because they slip it in a very young children's show that has been solid for years, so parents have grown to trust it, and the kids watching it have no idea that what they are absorbing is wrong and against the will of God. 
