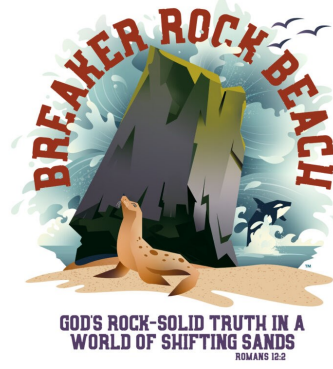

LOVING ARMS (HOMEBOUND) MINISTRY NURSING

Our Motto: Bringing the church to those who cannot come to church.

The Loving Arms team has a heart for those that love Jesus but have found it difficult or just can't make it to church and fellowship. So, we make it a priority to love on our shut-ins to show the love of Jesus. We pray that those we talk and visit with are blessed as much as we are.

Verses we live by:

Ezekiel 34:2 "This is what the Sovereign Lord says: Woe to you shepherds of Israel who only take care of yourselves! Should not shepherds take care of the flock?"

Matthew 25:40 "The King will reply, 'Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me.'"

In March, the team made 4 visits, 5 calls, 1 lunch, 2 funerals, and 1 program.

In April, the team made 5 visits, 5 calls, and 2 lunches were cancelled.

There was a request to visit and sit with a homebound member while his daughter/full time caregiver attends her bible study, runs errands and gets groceries. She is so appreciative of what the church is doing to help him and her.

A new couple has recently been added to our Loving Arms list of opportunities to minister with the loving care of Jesus.

To our Loving Arms Ministry Team: Thank you so much for your willingness and availability to show the love of Jesus to these wonderful people. The people this Ministry reaches are the very same individuals that provided for the work of the church in their lifetimes and may even have visited their elders too.

Each of our homebound would love a call, card or a visit. Even a drawing by a child, a meal, a plate of cookies, a word search puzzle, etc. would be a precious gift to them. Involve your children/grandchildren in a great experience!
