Curious Toddlers

Toddlers are small scientists. The whole world makes them curious! As your little scientist asks and you patiently answer, he is growing in his understanding of his world. Help model ways of seeking out information, too. When you see things in nature, wonder out loud so your toddler can hear: “I wonder where that squirrel lives?” “How does that ant know where to find food?” Then look up the information and read it aloud! Remind your toddler, **God made that animal. God is amazing!**

Try This:

We sing this song to the tune of “Old McDonald Had a Farm” while we play with whatever toy animals are around. “God made animals big and small, E-I-E-I-O; And here we see He made a horse, E-I-E-I-O.
