SPRING A Lesson 6

Find and Share Share with God's people who are in need. Romans 12:13

We keep a basket in the corner of our pantry—and call it our Sharing Basket. Whenever we get groceries, we pick up an extra can of beans or box of cereal for the Sharing Basket. Toys that my kids haven't played for a long time might also go there. When the basket is full, we decide together where to take the items—a food pantry, local mission or even directly to a family in need. I make sure my kids know, **Sharing** with people in need is a way to do what God says to do!

Try This:

Keep a change jar where all family members drop loose change. Our kids are really good at finding coins between cushions or in the car and dropping them in the jar! When it's full, we sort the coins at the kitchen table, count them and put them into rolls. We talk about who we know that might need our coins. The kids love to exchange the coins for bills to enclose and give to someone anonymously. It's fun to be a "stealth giving" family secret—kids love it that they helped!
