

SPRING A Lesson 7

Animal Creations

"How great you are, O Sovereign Lord! There is no one like you."

2 Samuel 7:22

At mealtimes or snack time, I tell my toddler food helps her grow. I ask, "What does a monkey need to grow?" If she doesn't answer, I say, "Food." Then I ask, "What does a puppy need to grow?" and continue asking, naming different animals, until she always answers, "Food!" I say, God makes animals grow. He makes food so they can eat and grow. And He makes food so YOU can grow!

Try This:

At bedtime, we look through a Bible storybook for stories with animals in them. As we read the story, I point to each animal and name it. Then we go back to that page and I say, "Find the giraffe!" and my toddler points to it. After he points to the animal, I say **God made** that (giraffe). After several times I ask, "Who made that (giraffe)?" so that my toddler can answer with me, "God did!"
