Dear Fellow Christians,

As the 2025 Hanover Christmas Mother I am coming to you and your congregation to help spread knowledge about the Hanover Christmas Mother Program across all of Hanover County. We want your members to know the program is there for support if their family or anyone they might know, needs a little help to ensure Christmas for their child/children. We also hope to reach charitable people who might not know about this option to spread support to Hanover children in need of Christmas joy. I know charitable giving is a personal choice, but I do ask for your consideration.

The Hanover Christmas Mother program has been operational since 1949. Today, the program is managed by the Doswell Ruritan Club. Each year a county-wide fundraising campaign is undertaken to fund the gifts to children of families in need. At the same time work is done to identify children and their families in need of support to ensure gifts and food are available for Christmas. The program coordinates with Hanover Social Services, but we know there are other families living with tight financial obligations. We want these families to know about the Christmas Mother Program if they need us.

In 2024, Hanover's Christmas Mother program provided help to ensure gifts and food for 1,381 children in 579 families. In addition, 72 seniors were also provided support with food for Christmas. What Joy! What Christian Love!

Those needing assistance for Christmas that are not included in the Social Services program are required to send a letter to the Hanover Christmas Mother detailing the circumstances surrounding their need for help. Please ensure that a mailing address and phone number are included so we can follow up to gather the additional information we require for eligibility. Mail to Hanover Christmas Mother, P.O. Box 39, Doswell, VA 23047.

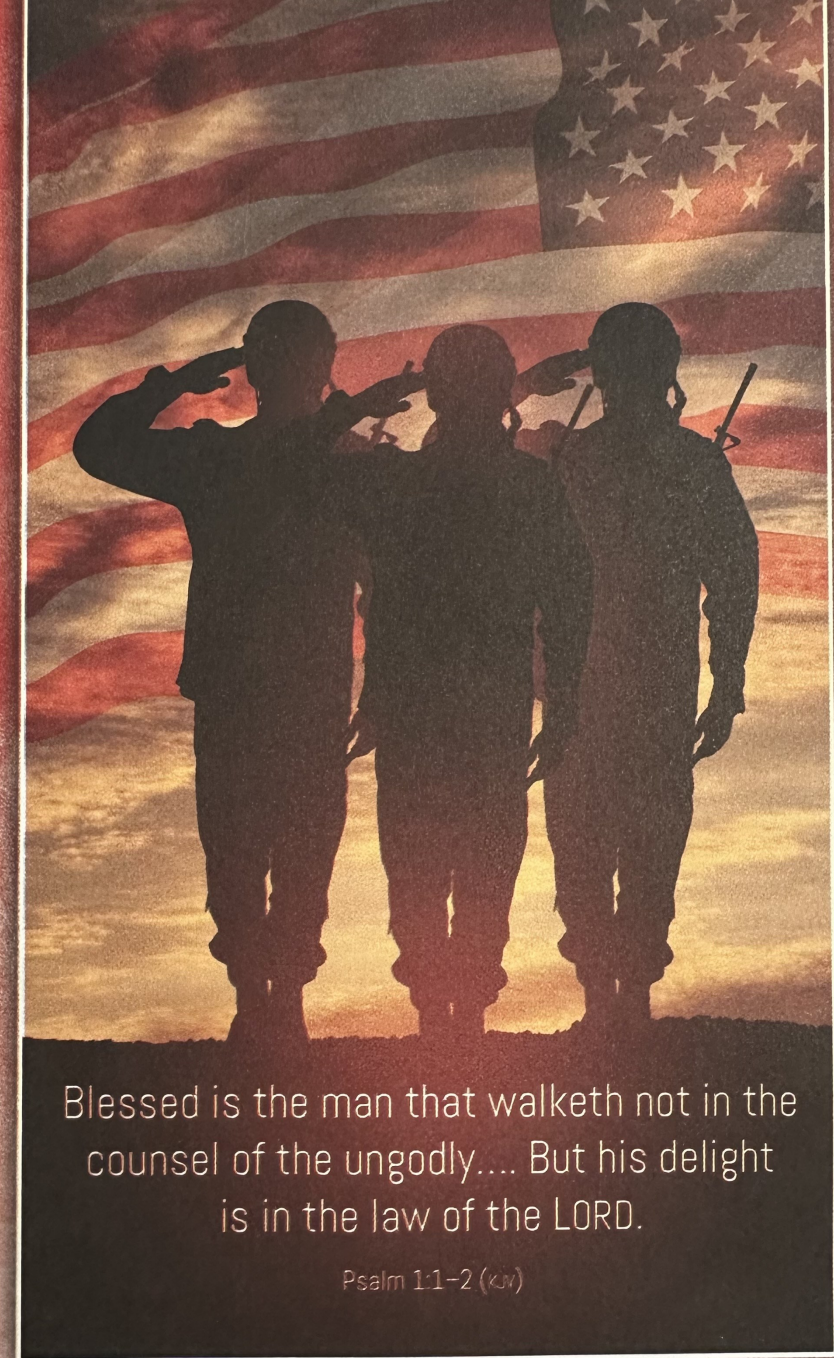
