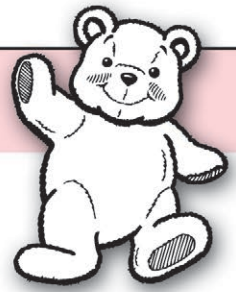


Family Together Time

Read Together

Look at the pretty sky. Can you point to the clouds? The Bible tells us that God made the sky.

Bible Words

“God made everything”

(based on Acts 17:24).

Pat the Bible as you say the Bible Words. Invite your child to pat the Bible and say the words too.

I can see the sky so blue.

(point to the sky)

I can reach and touch it too.

(reach toward the sky)

God made the sky for me to see.

(point to eyes)

I’m as happy as I can be.

(smile and clap hands)

Rhyme Together

Look at the Sky

Take an old blanket outside, and lie on it with your child. Talk about the beauty of God’s sky. Pick a cloud and tell your child what you think it looks like. Also look for birds and planes. Remember to thank God for making the sky.

Things to Do Together

Sky Chart

Choose a window in your home from which to look at the sky with your child. Each day, draw on a piece of paper a simple weather symbol to chart what you saw (sun, raindrop, cloud, and so forth). Thank God for making the sky.
